Trespassing

When you enter the front door to your building, please be aware of persons who may attempt to walk behind you into the building without using their KAC card. Intruders have accessed the buildings and the rooftops by following residents as they enter the building. Please remember that The Gateway buildings have controlled, not secure, access. Your help in excluding those persons who are not authorized to enter your building, is greatly appreciated.

The Gateway will again offer **Dynamic Parking** from February 1 thru 16 & February 20 thru February 21. The cost will be \$40 per day.

All residents are welcome to use the roof decks. We would like to remind residents that you are responsible for your guest's behavior and must pick up trash and litter before you leave the roof deck.

There is a Recycle for Change donation box in each apartment building. They will be able to accept the following items: clothing, shoes, handbags, backpacks, suitcases, toys, bedding towels, & books.
